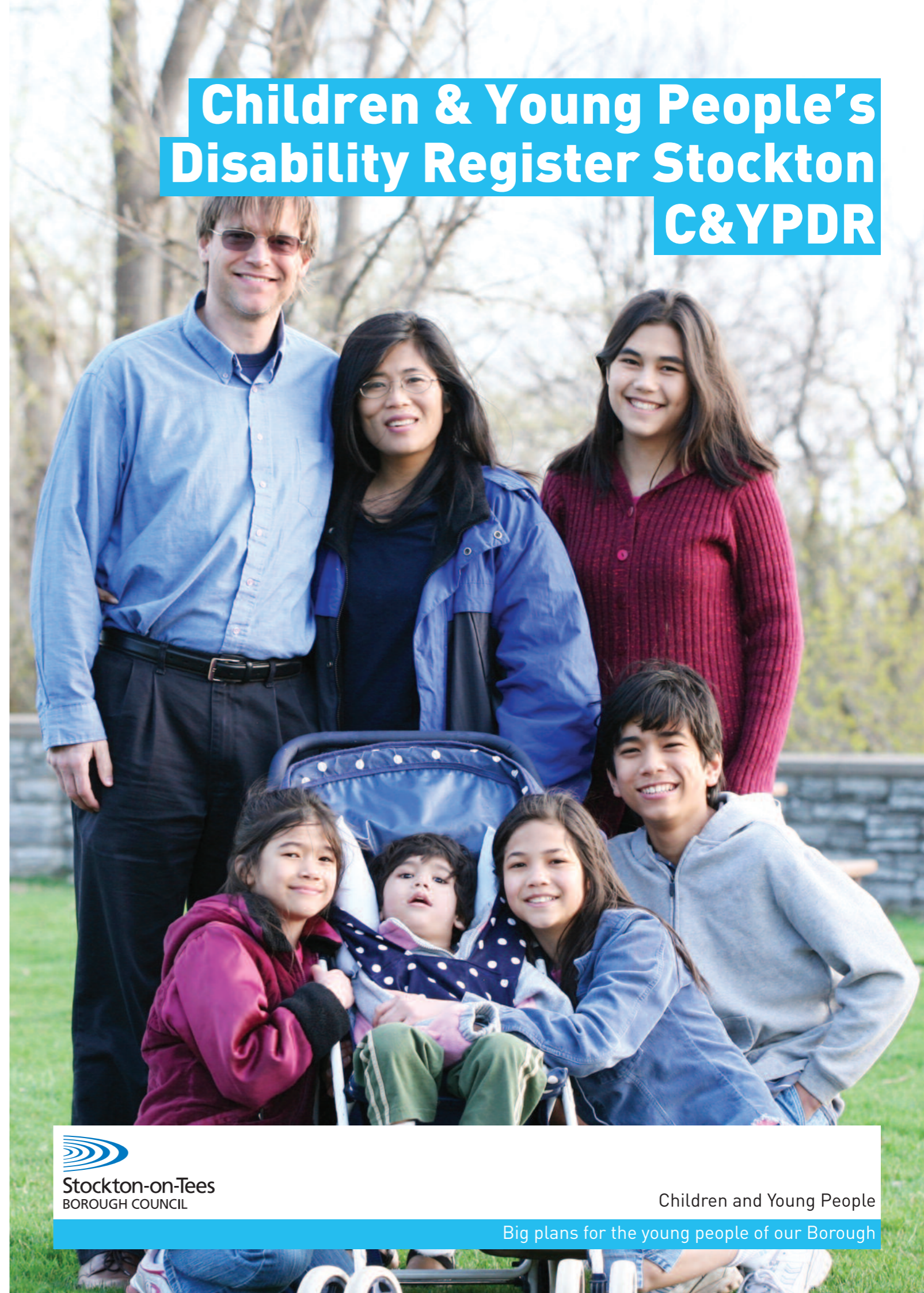

## What is The Register?

The Children & Young People's Disability Register Stockton is a confidential record of information about children and young people with disabilities living in the Stockton-on-Tees area. It will assist with service planning to meet the needs of children with disabilities and additional needs, now and in the future. Children's names are added to the register, and in return parents can receive information about services and special events available in their area.

## What will being on the Register do for me?

- Your information could influence service planning
- We can signpost you to local childcare
- You will be informed of ways you could get involved
- You will receive information and updates about services and events in your local area.

However, being on the register does not mean that your child will automatically be eligible for all services, health and children's services departments consider and assess all cases individually.

## Who will be eligible to be registered?

To be registered your child must have a learning difficulty, mental health, medical condition or a physical disability which has a substantial adverse effect on their ability to live and develop as other children of a similar age, be 0 to 17 years old and live in the borough of Stockton-on-Tees.

## What information will the register hold?

- Name, date of birth and address
- Condition or diagnosis
- Information about services already received
- Other basic details e.g. School, family information

## Who will see the information about my child?

Only professionals who need to know will have access to personal information about your child.

Other professionals will have access to general anonymous statistical information, this could include the number of children with a particular problem or postcodes to map needs in a particular area. The information held on the register is confidential and is held on a secure computerised system, it conforms to The Data Protection Act 1998.

## How long will my child stay on the register?

This is a voluntary register and you can opt to remove your child/young person at any time.

- If you no longer wish to be registered
- If you move out of the area
- Once your child reaches 18 years old
