

Dear parents and carers

In a recent survey, you told you wanted to know more about your child's behaviour in school.

We have listened to you and developed a new, more responsive, system for reporting pupil's behaviour to you.

From Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2017, every time your child receives a red or yellow card, we will send you a text or email. You will receive it on the same day or the day after. We do not necessarily want you to do anything in response, as hopefully one card will nip any problems in the bud, but it helps you to understand what sort of day your child has had.

If there are ongoing problems, it's likely that you will want to talk to us about any issues and we can show you why your child has been sanctioned. Hopefully, again, at that point a straightforward discussion will sort out any issues.

Teachers keep logs of why children have been given red or yellow cards and can talk to you about their reasons for giving cards out.

I hope that you feel that you know more about how your child is progressing in school and how their social skills and behaviour are developing, as a result of our new system.
