



30 hours child care solutions; working together

Due to the popularity of our free 30 hours provision offer at St Mark's Elm Tree Nursery, all of our 30 hour full day places are now allocated. However we still want to be able to provide parents with a solution to finding a 30 hours place which involves our new purpose built nursery. We have therefore decided to work in alliance with 'Good' and mainly 'Outstanding' childminds, that we have already built a strong relationship with, over years of sharing the care of many of our youngest children. We therefore suggest that an effective and safe way to access 30 hours free childcare, would be to take a 15 hour free morning place at our Nursery (5 mornings a week 9am-12) then take the remaining 15 hours, or more if needed, with one of our recommended childminders. At St Mark's Elm Tree Nursery we also offer a paid breakfast club from 8am-9am within our nurturing setting. This allows parents the flexibility to drop their children off early, in order to meet their own work commitments. One of the hardest things for every parent is to get that work/life balance right and along with that comes the huge hurdle of finding the right setting and routine for your child. We feel that our enabling and nurturing environment coupled with one of our recommended caring childminders could help you to achieve this balance and support your child in their earliest and most important years.
