This week's Topic: Superheroes

This week we will be continuing our learning with the popular theme of Superheroes. The children have really enjoyed creating a superhero 'hide out' in the stage area and making masks to hide their 'identity' from the 'villains'. The children have discovered that if they wear special 'super writing capes', they become super writers. Therefore this week we will continue mark making and writing in lots of different ways. This will include writing laid on the floor under the table and using invisible magic pens.

Things to do at home:

You could encourage your child to write at home. They could mark make a superhero secret message or think of and attempt to write their own superhero name. If your child is not keen on mark making with a pen or pencil yet, you could encourage them to use their finger to write in shaving foam or flour. Please send in any writing the children do at home for them to share in nursery.

Some of the children, who have packed lunch, are asking to try the school meals and we have had some enquires from parents about changing. The majority of children now have a school meal and are really enjoying them. The children who have changed from a packed lunch to a hot meal are doing really well with the new routine, developing their table manners and using cutlery.
