




St. Mark's CofE Nursery

This half term's theme is 'All about me'

Our overarching topic this half term is 'All about me'. Our learning in Nursery is child-led and follows their interests and preferences. Some of the children have started to bring autumn leaves and conkers into nursery to share with the group. They are aware of the changing weather and have noticed new vegetables such as pumpkins in the shops. We have decided the children need more of an understanding of what happens at this time of year and so that they can continue to explore the changing of the seasons; we will focus their learning around 'All things autumn' next week. This will involve a range of learning experiences, including some food tasting. If your child has any allergies that you have not already told us about please inform a member of the Nursery staff.

Simple things such as, encouraging your child to put on their own wellies and fasten their coat is an important part of their learning journey at this time of year. Collecting autumn items and talking about natural changes, such as the leaves changing colour helps children to learn new vocabulary, explore with their senses and understand the world around them. Please send in anything you find on your walk for our autumn display. We have lots of conkers already from your walks so thank you for these, they are being used in counting activities.
