We will also be thinking about the colour brown as well as discussing our emotions and how we know how someone else is feeling.

We will also be taking part in World Book Day on Thursday 7th March, where all children can come dressed up as their favourite character or bring in their favourite book to share with us.

Things to do at home:

You might talk to your child about different emotions and how your child can recognise them in themselves, e.g. tears when they are upset, clenched fist/shouting when they are angry etc. You might want to help your child draw a happy face or a sad, upset, angry face etc. Please send in any pictures that your child would like to show to the rest of nursery.
