Dear parents/carers,

As we begin a new half term - knowing that further national measures are likely to come into place from this Thursday - I would like to thank parents/carers for your support and understanding in uncertain times. School follow our own risk assessments, that are regularly updated and checked by the local authority health and safety team, as well as following the direct decisions made by Public Health England in the event of any positive cases; I thank you for supporting us with the actions that are needed.

I would like to remind parents/carers of the measures that are in place and ask that you continue to adhere to them (drop off and collection times, social distance measures, not turning up too early on site, only 1 person dropping or collecting, no access to the school office etc...) Directors have asked that I tell parents/carers that masks can be worn on site should parents/carers feel they would like to.

On a final note, it is crucial that school are made aware when a test has been booked for a child who attends the school or when households receive a positive test result. (Please do follow the Public Health England rules that state a test should ONLY be booked if one or more of the 3 symptoms are shown.) You can ring school with this information during school office hours.
