

What are the ARB learning in the Autumn term?

Egyptians

The children in the ARB are going to be learning about the Egyptians and all of their learning will be based around this theme.

Geography - We will be finding out about Egypt both historically and now and how it compares to the UK.

Science - We will be learning about the human body including the skeleton, circulatory system and organs.

Art - In Art we are going to be using 3D materials to create canopic jars and will be taking inspiration from Ancient Egyptian artefacts.

P.E. - In PE this term the children will be learning about tag rugby, the rules and the skills needed to be able to confidently play a game.

D.T. - We will be learning about levers and pulleys and how these may have been used to build pyramids.

Computing - In computing the children will be learning more about algorithms, they will use sequencing, selection and repetition to make characters carry out certain acts on their screens.

SEMH - Alongside the usual PSHE curriculum, we will be looking closely at the children understanding themselves and their self-esteem.

Maths

Mrs Mallam: In Maths, will begin by looking at place value and look at a variety of methods to represent numbers. We will then move on to looking at addition and subtraction

Mr Wilson: The term will start with place value, recapping prior knowledge and extending the children's understanding. Children will look at larger numbers and how the rules of place value do not change. We will then move on to addition and subtraction using increasingly larger numbers.

English

Mrs Mallam: We will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts and be looking at retrieval and sequencing events.

Whilst writing we will begin by concentrating on word classes and sentence structure and will look at writing a non-chronological report and diary entry.

Mr Wilson: We will focus on both fiction and non-fiction texts and look closely at how we understand what we are reading.

We will begin our writing by recapping word classes and looking at sentence structure and punctuation. We will be writing a persuasive argument and a diary entry.
