Maths

We are learning about angles and turns, including different types of angles and how to use a protractor to accurately measure how many degrees are in a given turn. Finally we will be looking at how timetables work and how we use them in our daily life to know when and where we need to be.

English

This half term, Y5 will be writing persuasive letters to local shops to ask for donations. This will help the with our Y5 project for the children not attending the residential trip. We will also be writing diaries including Y5 spelling, punctuation and grammar.

RE

We are looking at the Big Frieze that we use as a part of Understanding Christianity. We are exploring the deeper meaning of the Salvation story, and what Jesus' sacrifice meant to Christians.

Science

We are working scientifically this half term. We will be setting up experiments and recording our data in different ways, such as tables and graphs. We will be writing predictions and conclusions. We will also be taking part in Science Week, w.c. 11th March

Geography

In Geography we are carrying on with our learning of aquatic biomes, with a focus on seas and oceans.

Art

In Art the children will be looking at Andy Warhol and Banksy and will be creating a self portrait in their style.

We are looking at how money can be used, earned, saved, spent and donated. This will help us to understand the wider world of work and how to budget.

We are focussing on tennis and cricket.
