English

This half term, children will be writing a biography. They will look at using Fronted Adverbials and Apostrophes for Possession. Children will then write an independent piece on their own subject.

Maths

In maths we will be looking at measurement. Children will be reading scales (extending to decimal notation) and developing their understanding of concepts such as equivalence through units on mass and capacity and temperature.

RE

Children will look at the deeper meanings of festivals through the lens of three different religions. They will look at similarities and differences and will also look at what it means to be a Sikh in Britain today.

Science

This half term, we will be looking at living things and their habitats. Children will be using classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.

History

This half term, children will be learning about the impact Roman Empire on Britain. They will think about how the Romans invaded Britain and how Roman rule impacted daily life.

DT

This half term, children will be looking at creating working light-houses. They will create simple circuits to make a light at the top work and a pulley system to bring an object to the top.

PSHE/RSE

This half term, children will be looking at healthy and unhealthy food choices and the similarities and differences in fast food and fruit and vegetables. The children will be learning to understand the importance of brushing their teeth and visits to the dentist.

P.E.

Children will be learning the skills needed to play cricket as well as extending on the dance skills they learned in Spring term. In cricket, children will learn how to bowl and bat accurately and correctly, before strengthening their catching skills as a fielder. In dance the focus will be on choreography and control of movement.

Computing

Children will look at creating PowerPoints. They will look at using a range of different tools to change the look, style and animations of their work. Children will create a PowerPoint that they can then present to each other.
