Maths

In maths we will be looking at measurement. Children will be reading scales (extending to decimal notation) and developing their understanding of concepts such as equivalence through units on mass and capacity, temperature, and money. This half term we will also be adding additional multiplication lessons to our

English

This half term, children will be writing a biography. They will learn how to use apostrophes for possession correctly and how to write in standard English. Children will then move on to writing a non chronological report. They will learn how to use fronted adverbials and how to maintain an accurate tense throughout a piece of writing

RE

This term, the children in Year 4 will be looking at the story of Pentecost. This will lead onto a discussion about the Kingdom of God and what this means for Christian.

Science

This half term, we will be looking at living things and their habitats. Children will be using classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.

History

This half term, children will be learning about the impact Roman Empire on Britain. They will think about how the Romans invaded Britain and how Roman rule impacted daily life.

DT

This half term, children will be looking at creating working lighthouses. They will create simple circuits to make a light at the top work and a pulley system to bring an object to the top.

PSHE/RSE

During Summer, Year 4 are going to be introduced to puberty. We will go into detail around personal hygiene and managing emotions but will learn briefly about changes to the body.

P.E.

In PE this term, the children will be revisiting cricket and dance. The children will be learning to throw under arm with accuracy and catch from a further distance.

Computing

Children will look at creating PowerPoints. They will look at using a range of different tools to change the look, style and animations of their work. Children will create a PowerPoint that they can then present to each other.

Music

Music, this term, is focusing on classical music. This will then progress to the children looking at composing a four bar piece of music.
