English

This half term in Year 1, we are starting by spelling and reading set 2 and set 3 words to help us prepare for the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check. We will then retell a familiar story then write our own, with a focus on exclamation sentences. We will consolidate our learning on question sentences and using punctuation appropriately.

Maths

This half term in Year 1, we are going to understand position and direction we will begin by understanding the terminology above, below, left and right. We will then move onto understanding full turns, quarter turns and half turns. We will complete a week of place value to 100. Over the last couple of weeks we will embed all of our learning we have covered across maths in Year 1 and anything we might need some extra consolidation on.

RE

In RE this half term, we will be exploring the question, 'What makes some places sacred to believers?' We will begin by naming special places in different religions and identifying the symbols we can recognise within each that are special to that religion.

Science

In Science we are going to be learning about animals including humans. To begin with we will look at adults and their offspring. We will then move onto the life cycle of different species. Children will embed their understanding of what animals and humans need to survive.

Geography

This half term, we will be learning about the oceans and continents in more detail. We will be thinking like Geographers to answer questions like 'Would a country exist without people?' We will learn about the layers of the earth and their names and purpose.

Art

In Art, we will be learning all about collage and how we can use it to express our ideas and imaginations. We will be learning about Kurt Schwitters and Eric Carle, and exploring the collage techniques they used to create their artwork.

RSHE

In RSHE we will be learning about what it means to be healthy. We will discuss the things that we need to be healthy and why they are important. We will also be looking at game playing and how we can benefit from playing team games.

P.E.

In Athletics, we are working hard on our long jumping as we explore different types of jumps and practise the skills we need to improve our work. We are also learning about Outdoor Adventurous Activities (OAA) and developing our teamwork skills by completing a range of challenges.

Computing

In Computing we are going to be understanding algorithms and learning how to debug an algorithm. We will use the bee bots to create an algorithm for our partners and the iPads with the bee bot app.

Music

In Music, we will be refining our performance skills in preparation for our end of year celebration assembly. We will also be exploring graphic scores and composing
