### Maths

In Maths, the children will be completing their Multiplication Checks throughout June.

As well as this, they will be learning how to multiply and divide by 1 digit numbers, understand position on graphs and look at statistics.

### English

In English, children will be recapping the spelling, punctuation and grammar skills they have learnt this year. They will be using this to write their own ode poem.

The children will then be writing in a genre of their choice about being in Year 4. After that, the children will be writing an advert.

### RE

During the last half term of Year 4, the children are looking at the quote 'Life is a Journey'.

They will then explore different religions and the different key ceremonies that take place.

### Science

In Science, children will be learning about plants. They will be learning about the different parts of a plant and their function. They will also be looking at the flower and its role in a plant's life-cycle. We will finish the term by looking at food chains.

### Geography

This term, we will be looking at our fieldwork unit. We will be looking at Rivers and coasts and how our local area makes money. The children will be looking at a range of different ways that they can investigate and enhance their fieldwork skills

### Art

In art, children will be learning about the artists Georgia O'Keeffe and Claude Monet. They will then be creating floral paintings inspired by them.

### PSHE/RSE

PSHE/RSE continues from last half term. The children will go into further detail about how their bodies will change during puberty.

### P.E.

Children will be completing a series of Outdoor Adventurous Activities to develop their orientation, communication and problem-solving skills. Children will also be fine tuning their existing running, jumping, throwing and catching skills to increase their athletic performance.

### Computing

This half term, we will be looking at programming using scratch. We will look at how to draw shapes and then how we can adapt our code to change the size, shape and colour of our shapes.

### Music

The music this term will revisit singing and focus on the performance of songs. The children will also learn about adding musical instruments to compliment songs.
