English

We are working hard to use Year 3 SPG in our writing, such as inverted commas for directed speech, fronted adverbials and apostrophes for possession. We will do this by teaching the children to write three main text types: Newspaper article, a non-chronological report and a science fiction story.

Maths

In maths we will spend some time looking at fractions. We will then move on to looking at perimeter and area before moving on to properties of shapes including angles. We will also focus on the 3 x tables.

RE

In RE we will begin our topic of Sikhism. We will start with looking at the origins of the Sikh faith, we will look at the Gurus and who they were as well as looking at how Sikhs worship in Britain today.

Science

Children will look at states of matter in Science this half term. They will look at Solids, Liquids and Gases. How processes can change these from one to another and how processes can be reversible and irreversible.

Geography

In Geography, Children will be looking at the water cycle. They will learn how water evaporates from the earth before it condenses in the air to form clouds and then falls to earth in the form of precipitation.

Art

In art this term, the children will be looking at creating collages using a variety of different mediums. They evaluate and take inspiration from a range of different sources and focus on the artist Rosalind Freeborn.

In RSHE we will be learning about how we can stay safe and keep healthy. This will include talking about rules in different situations.
