

KS2 MFL LTP overview

KS2 - Aims

- understand and respond to spoken and written language from a variety of authentic sources
- speak with increasing confidence, fluency and spontaneity, finding ways of communicating what they want to say, including through discussion and asking questions, and continually improving the accuracy of their pronunciation and intonation
- can write at varying length, for different purposes and audiences, using the variety of grammatical structures that they have learnt
- discover and develop an appreciation of a range of writing in the language studied.

KS2 - Content

Pupils should be taught to:

- listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding
- explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words
- engage in conversations; ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others; seek clarification and help*
- speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures
- develop accurate pronunciation and intonation so that others understand when they are reading aloud or using familiar words and phrases*
- present ideas and information orally to a range of audiences
- read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing
- appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language
- broaden their vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new words that are introduced into familiar written material, including through using a dictionary
- write phrases from memory, and adapt these to create new sentences, to express ideas clearly
- describe people, places, things and actions orally* and in writing
- understand basic grammar appropriate to the language being studied, including (where relevant): feminine, masculine and neuter forms and the conjugation of high-frequency verbs; key features and patterns of the language; how to apply these, for instance, to build sentences; and how these differ from or are similar to English.

Progression of Skills

Year 3/4

- Children in LKS2 will focus on vocabulary.
- They will learn simple translations which can be tailored to their interests and which words in particular they want to learn
- There will be no expectation to insert these words into sentences.

Year 5/6

- Children in UKS2 will focus on grammatical structure using the vocabulary that they have learnt in previous years.
- Each half term will follow the same Vocabulary focus as LKS2 to keep consistency between year groups so that siblings in year 5 and 3 can share their knowledge at home.
- The vocabulary that the children have learnt during LKS2 will be used in basic sentences such as: J'aime or J'ai.
- Complexity will be added as the children familiarise themselves with the basic grammar structure using: negative structures (ne - pas), adjectives, (grand, belle/beau, minion), opinions (parce que c'est...) and further verbs (adorer, detester). If the year group are become more able, add different pronouns (tu, il/elle)
