



Year 3

English

We are working hard on a range of text types which include— a newspaper article, non-chronological report, science fiction story and performance poetry. Within this we will focus on a range of spelling punctuation and grammar. Some of these will be inverted commas, past tense, third person, subordinating clauses and similes.

Maths

We are working hard in Maths learning about fractions, comparing and ordering unit and non-unit fractions. Counting in fractions on a number line and being able to add and subtract unit fractions. We will also be looking at length and perimeter and properties of shapes, including angles.

RE

We are looking at the Sikh religion and how Sikhs celebrate different festivals, where they worship, their different beliefs and how we can compare this to other religions.

Science

This term we will be looking at animals including humans which will involve looking at where we get energy from in our food and the structure of the skeleton.

Geography & History

In geography, we are learning all about the water cycle and why it is important. We will also be looking at structures of rivers and different rivers around the world. In History, we are learning about the Bronze age to the Iron age and how lives changed during these periods.

Art & DT

Year 3 pupils are exploring Pop Art through the work of Roy Lichtenstein and David Hockney while developing their sketching skills. They will learn to use the grid method and explore how lines and shapes can create texture in art.

RSHE

In RSHE we will be learning about how we can stay safe and keep healthy. This will include talking about rules in different situations.

P.E.

We will be looking at Dance and Football. During our Dance lessons, we will explore movements and learn to choreograph and perform short routines. In Football, we will be various skills such as control, passing and receiving to play small-sided games.

Computing

We will be using Scratch to programme a sequence that includes sounds.

Music

We will be listening to Jazz music and being introduced to using keyboards from Tees Valley Music School.
