**Maths**

In maths we will be looking at measurement. Children will be reading scales (extending to decimal notation) and developing their understanding of concepts such as equivalence through units on mass and capacity and temperature.

**English**

This half term, children will be writing a biography about William Shakespeare. We will also be writing a travel guide based on our History topic of Ancient Greece. We will teach the children to use prepositions. For each of these topics, children will write a supported and independent piece.

**RE**

In RE, we will be looking at the Understanding Christianity unit of 'What is the Trinity and why is it important for Christians?' We will also be looking at how 3 different religions (Christianity, Judaism and Sikhism) mark significant events of life

**Science**

In science, the children will be focusing on the topics of 'Rocks'. They will be identifying and classifying rocks looking at the permeability of different rock types and describe how fossils are formed.

We will also be looking at the different functions of a flowering plant and the requirements plants need for life.

**History / Geography**

In History, we will be learning about Ancient Greece and the impact that it had on Britain today. In Geography, we will be looking at climate zones and what they are.

**DT / Art**

In DT, we will be looking at mechanisms. Children will add a circuit and pulley to create a lighthouse, linked to the Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch.

In Art, 3 we are exploring sculpture, focusing on creating their own Egyptian Death Mask.

**PSHE/RSE**

In PSHE, we will be learning about food groups and identifying healthy and unhealthy food choices. We will be 'food detectives', trying some different fruits and vegetables and we will learn about the importance of a balanced diet.

**P.E.**

During this term, children will be continuing to develop choreography in dance by demonstrating various skills such as repetition and synchronisation with others. We will also be working on Zone Cricket, where children will learn to accurately strike the ball, how to successfully aim for a target, as well as using their throwing skills.

**Computing**

Children will look at word processing. They will look at using a range of different tools to change the look, style and images in their work. Children will create a document that contains both images and text.

**Music**

In Music, we will be looking at Music from ABBA and how this has shaped music today. We will also be learning to play the keyboards with Mrs Gallo-way
