

Maths

This term, children will strengthen their counting skills and learn to recognise numbers to 10 confidently. They'll also explore the number system more deeply, focusing on numbers that are important to them and those they encounter in everyday life. The children will have plenty of hands-on opportunities to use and develop their maths vocabulary in a fun and engaging way.

History

The children will look at timelines of their life and how they have grown up. We will also learn about timely events including Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day.

Geography

Children will explore their local environment and learn how maps help us find our way. They'll even have a chance to use Google Maps to locate familiar places!

P.E

In PE, we will learn how to move around safely, stop without bumping into anything, and share our equipment with friends. We'll also practice working by ourselves, with a partner, and in groups. We will begin practising fundamental movement skills, including running, jumping and skipping.

Literacy

We will learn how to match sounds to letters in reading and writing during our daily phonics sessions, using visuals and phrases to support our learning. The children will practice learning each other's names and writing their own.

We will explore new books, thinking about what is happening in the story and we will learn new vocabulary linked to these stories. We will write initial sounds linked to these stories, progressing to three-letter words.

Science

We will begin this term by discussing our wonderful human body. We will look at how body parts are used and learn new vocabulary, we will consider how we are all different and similarities, moving on to healthy eating and the effects food can have on a healthy body.

Art/DT

In Art, we will practise printing skills, using different tools including our fingerprints and fruit. We will then move onto making collages using both natural and man-made materials. In DT, we will explore ingredients, including practising some baking skills. We will also explore textiles — this will include weaving fabrics and making props.

Computing

Children will become familiar with using different types of technology, like iPads and smartboards, giving them the chance to build confidence and have fun with ICT.

RE

In RE, children will begin by learning about being special, what makes them special and about having a sense of belonging. They will also hear some stories and songs about being special. In Autumn 2, our learning will be centred around the Christian celebration of Christmas. Daily worship will take place and Christian Values will be promoted.

PSED

Children will be learning the expectations of school life. They will have opportunities to create and understand simple rules and practise them in everyday contexts. Children will learn about hygiene. They will learn important social skills including how to share and take turns.

Music

As musicians, we are exploring growth through song and accompanying rhythms. Rhyme time will incorporate lots of much-loved Nursery Rhymes that the children will be able to recall from memory. We will begin to learn worship songs and later in the term, Nativity songs!
